


#### How long have you lived in Zavalla?




#### Where do you reside in the Zavalla Community?




#### How satisfied are you with life in Zavalla right now?




#### Do you think Zavalla needs changes to improve its future?

- I would love to be able to say that Zavalla has an inclusive community that is interested in growing, but retains small town values.


- Our water to not be the worst in the state. Our school and education to improve tremendously. We need to have set in stone police officers and members of the city hall.


- Road maintenance
